The Collective Agreement is a contract between you and the employer. It has clear language and guidelines that protect your rights as a worker at the college, providing

information on how much you can work and for how long, health and safety considerations, leave time, and much much more.

When in doubt about anything about your job duties or your supervisor's expectations, consult your copy of the Collective Agreement for clarity.

PARTICIPATE: General membership meetings take place every month on both campuses. The timing varies between noon hour meetings and after-work meetings to accommodate members' schedules and commitments. Your voice and vote can have an impact at meetings, so we urge you to show up. Check the website for meeting dates, times and locations.

JOIN: The local's work is driven by committees for specific aspects of work at the college. Members are always welcome to join a committee, especially if you have an area of knowledge or want to learn more. There's even a Comfort Committee that provides cards and flowers for members who have experienced a difficult time or loss.
